

# Fowler claims Senior title

LITTLETON — Les Fowler of Boulder easily won his fourth State Senior Stroke Play tournament Thursday at Raccoon Creek Golf Course.

Fowler, 65, shot a 2-over-par 74 in Thursday's final round to claim a five-stroke victory over fellow Boulder Country Club member Pete Bloomer and Bert Welz of Littleton. The former state senator finished with a 54-hole total of 223.

Fowler came into the day tied for the lead with Welz, but picked up five shots when Welz

shot a 79 Thursday. Bloomer finished the tournament with a 77.

Fowler, who had previously won this tournament in 1978, '80 and '83, is just one victory shy of the record for this event, five by Greeley's Larry Eaton.
