## Pros Win Colorado Cup, Amateurs Take Colorado Senior Cup

For the past 22 years the Colorado Golf Association and the Colorado Section of the PGA have competed against one another in the Colorado Cup Matches for the bragging rights of Colorado golf. Each organization selects their top players based on points and selection by their respective tournament committees. The top twelve players are selected to compete in a one-day 36-hole shootout that combines four-ball and individual match play competition. For the past twelve years the CGA and Colorado PGA have also selected the top senior players to compete in the Colorado Senior Cup Matches. Coming into this year's event at Bear Creek Golf Club on August 23rd the pros held a 16-5 edge in the regular competition, with two ties, and led 6-5 in the senior matches.

Competing for the CGA cup team were Mark Crabtree, Tim Burns, Rick DeWitt, Pat Fry, Jeff Fujimoto, Rick Garber, Mark Hirsch, Dennis Lucero, Carter Mathies, Robert Odom, Cam Osler and John Segelke. Named to the amateur team but unable to compete were Paul Alexander, John Luoma and Mike Troyer, each of whom qualified for the U.S. Amateur Championship played the same week. Colorado Open Champion Brian Guetz was unable to compete due to his return to Oklahoma State.

On the pros' side were Gregg Jones, Ken Krieger, Ron Vlosich, Mike Zaremba, Tom Clary, Zane Zwemke, Tom Woodard, Kirk Cavarra, Chris Johnson, Stacey Hart, Nigel Rouse and Bill Loeffler.

Representing the senior amateurs were Larry Eaton, John Golden, Roger Gunderson, John Hamer, Bob Heiny, John Kaiser, Grant Maples, Chuck Melvin, Gary Potter and Bert Welz. For the senior pros, Clayton Cole, Jim Johnson, Vic Kline, Bill Majure, Larry Wheeler, Ralph Haddad, J.R. Delich, Don Fox, Bernie Petrie and Pat Rae.

In this year's event at Bear Creek, Tom Woodard of South Suburban Golf Course and Ron Vlosich of Green Gables Country Club led the 12-man team of Colorado Section professionals to victory with wins in both their four-ball and individual matches. Englewood's Chris Johnson and Ken Krieger of Cheyenne also were two-time winners helping the pros to a 10 and ½ to 7 and ½ point win over the amateurs. With the win the professionals increased their series lead to 17-5.

In the senior division the amateurs

outscored the pros 10 to 5 to tie that series at six each. Roger Gunderson of Aurora Hills, John Kaiser of Fox Hollow, John Golden of Perry Park, and Grant Maples of Meridian won both of their matches to lead the amateurs to their second straight win.
