

Mathies And Mork Win CGA Two-Man Team Title

The Colorado Golf Association ran its first Two-Man Team Championship in 1972. The inaugural event was won by Gary Longfellow (who has since been inducted into the Colorado Golf Hall of

Fame) and Gary Potter of Denver Country Club. Since that first year no team has ever repeated as Two-Man Champions. Longfellow and Dave Brown of Inverness Golf Club have twice been on winning teams (Longfellow in 1972 with Gary Potter, and in 1988 with Don Keffer, and Brown with Mike Musgrave in 1985, and in 1990 with Tom McGraw) however, the same team has never won twice.

That record looked like it was finally going to be broken in 1994 when the CGA Two-Man was held at Arrowhead Golf Course on June 21-23. The Two-Man combines three different formats over the 54-hole championship. The first day teams play a two-man scramble, followed by a four-ball (best ball) and finally foursome stroke play ("Scotch" or alternating shots). After the first two rounds, the 1991 Two-Man champs Mark Crabtree of Collindale Golf Course and Rick DeWitt of Indian Tree shared the lead with Carter Mathies and Eric Mork of Columbine Country Club. The battle was joined.

After the first nine of the final round Mathies and Mork took a one stroke lead and added to it when Crabtree and DeWitt bogied the par-four 10th hole. A par at 13 and a birdie at 14 by Crabtree and DeWitt tied the tournament with four holes remaining. It was at that point that Crabtree

and DeWitt fell victims to the "no-repeat" curse playing the final four holes in one-over par while Mathies and Mork played them in two-under.
